In literacy this week we will be focusing on fluency and expression when reading aloud. We will be paying particular attention to punctuation marks as we read. We will also be working on our comprehension skills as we learn to ask and answer questions about the texts we've read.

In numeracy this week we will be focussing on subtraction strategies including counting back from the biggest number, finding the difference and using our knowledge of how addition and subtraction are inversely related. P3's will be solving 2 digit number problems by partitioning the tens and ones.

In technologies we will be learning to log onto the laptops and Glow. We will be building our keyboard familiarity as we start to learn to touch type. We will be learning about Scotland this week as we use maps to plot cities and landmarks and explore how a key can be a useful tool.
